	<b>Plastic Soft Drink Bottles</b> <b>Plastic Jugs &amp; Bottles</b>  thru 	<b>Rinse clean and Drain, Flatten.</b> Place in 95 gallon toter Do not bag.	No plastic wrap or bags. No bottles used for hazardous materials such as antifreeze and motor oil. No styrofoam (peanuts, etc.) No unmarked plastic
	<b>Newspapers w/ inserts</b> <b>Magazines &amp; Catalogs</b> <b>White Paper</b> <b>Telephone Books</b> <b>Cereal Boxes</b>	<b>Do not tie. 	<b>Corrugated</b>	<b>Must be flattened</b> Wax free. Cut to 2' x 2', bind with twine, place on lid.	No waxed boxes.

▼ Scheduled weekly curbside solid waste

- All trash must fit in a Town issued 65 gallon toter. **The lid must close.**
- Toters must be placed at the curbside by 7am on your designated collection day. Following collection bins must be removed from the curbside by 7pm.
- If you have over flow, you must buy Town issued bags available at the DPW & Recycling Center.
- Bulky waste/large items (Limit one per week) Burnable items such as sofas, etc...
- White goods metals collection: Call E. L. Harvey & Sons at 1-800-321-3002**
- NO Hazardous materials, paints or TVs collected with curbside waste.
- Residents are required to contract with a private hauler for large clean outs over 6 bags.

▼ Drop-Off Recycling Center

119 South Maple Street, Hours: Sat. 8am - 2pm, Sun: 8am - 2pm (summer only). Times may vary.

- All curbside recycling materials accepted
  - 20 lb. propane tanks must be empty
  - Scrap, metal container available
  - Yard waste and brush area
  - Book Recycling - See container marked "Books for charity"
  - White goods or appliances accepted
- Worn or Torn Clothing
  - Tires no rims, 1-4 free, \$5 each additional
  - Paint drop-off shed.
  - Dead car batteries
  - Mercury collected at recycle center
  - NO hazardous waste
  - NO motor oil
  - NO commercial disposal
  - NO bulk waste
  - Trash must be in yellow Town overflow bags available for purchase on site.

▼ Yard Waste Days

- Yard waste collections will be made on Saturdays during the Spring and Fall. All yard waste must be placed in **paper biodegradable bags**, which can be purchased at local stores.

(PLEASE REFER TO COLOR CODED CALENDAR - Match Street Letter Code on Calendar)

WHERE to recycle:

On your recycling day just put your 95 gallon toter out with your regular solid waste by 7:00 a.m. Rain or shine.  
E. L. Harvey & Sons will pick up your recyclable materials. Recyclables and solid waste will be collected by separate trucks.

WHEN to recycle:

Your recycling day will be your regular solid waste day every other week. Check the calendar attached for your scheduled weeks.
